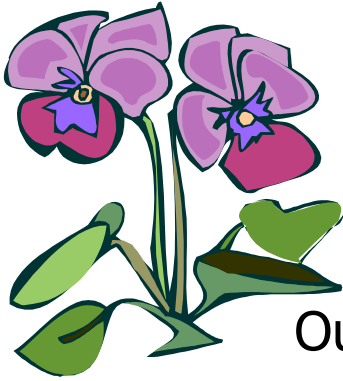
This month we will be discussing our likes and dislikes. We will be talking about foods, toys, tv shows, clothes, etc. A lot of talking will be going on this month.
