


# Panda June News

with Sandy & Ginny

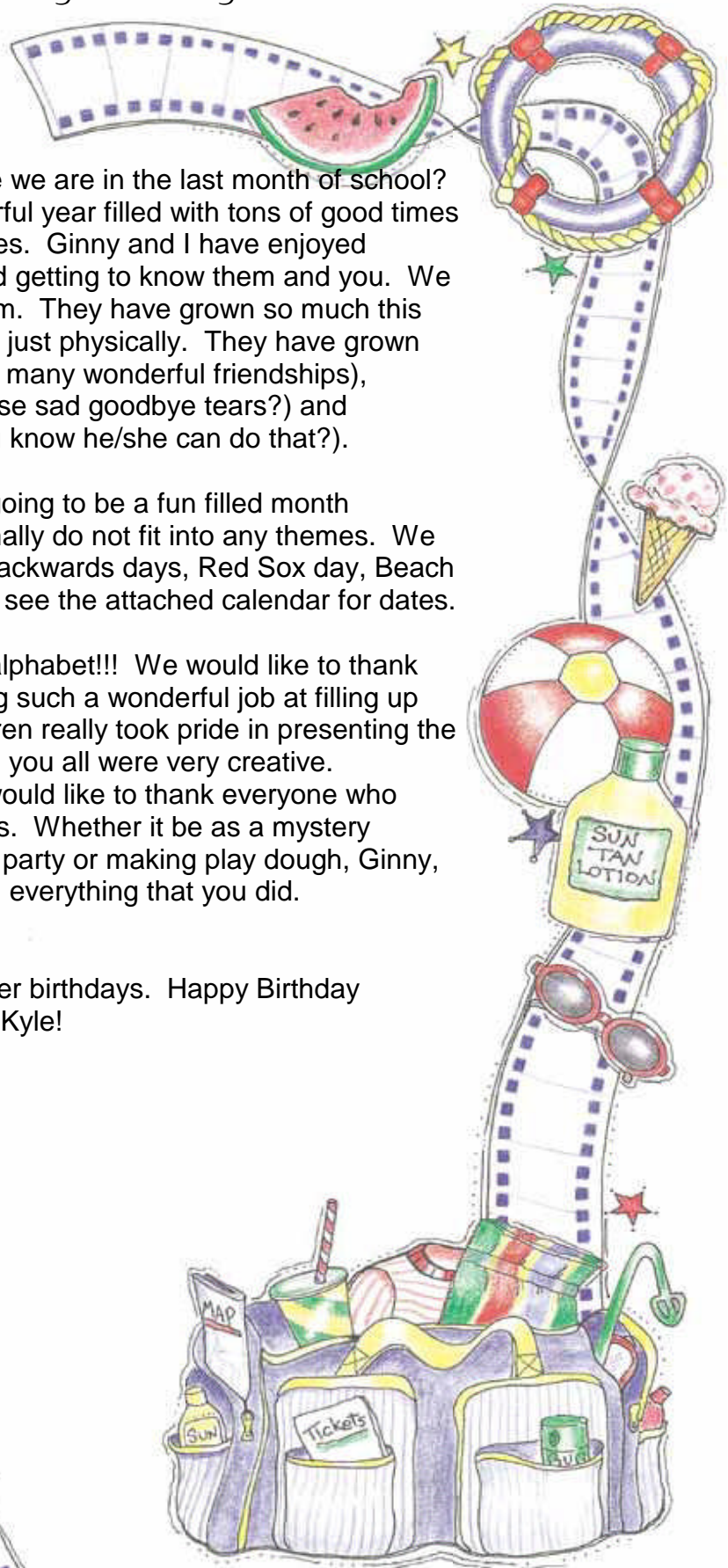


